Help inform CA wildfire policies:

Participate in a Wildfire Risk Mitigation Study

Researchers from San Jose State
University are asking for your help in providing insights on your experience navigating wildfire risk management and planning on your residence or property. We are conducting site evaluations and interviews with residents of Felton, Happy Valley and Redwood Estates to discuss their diverse experiences, innovations, and struggles with mitigating wildfire risk.



There are 2 ways to participate:

- 1. **Site evaluations:** We seek 25 volunteers for in-depth site evaluations. It is important that you prepare for the fire season in your planned manner and not let our visits influence your actions—no need to tidy up for us! If selected, residents will receive a \$100 Amazon gift card for opening their property up to our student researchers, who will perform two site visits: (1) spring or early summer and (2) fall. Participants will also be asked to complete a 20-60 minute interview conversation with the social science team. If selected, residents will receive a \$100 Amazon gift card once the site visits and interview are completed.
- 2. Interviews: We are collecting data on resident experiences navigating wildfire risk mitigation on private property to learn more about what is going well and what challenges remain when addressing wildfire risk in your area. Interviews typically take 20-60 minutes and can occur in-person or via Zoom.
